



Notable Developments



- Gol is attempting to assert greater role in anti-AQI alliance formation; however the levels of PM and OCinC situational awareness and direct engagement, as well as exact agendas, are uncertain.
- Some of these groups are initiating requests for support from the Government of Iraq, not just CF.
- Sunni insurgent, local population directly confronting AQI in Baghdad, fueling perception of growing movement
- SAA overture to Sadrists may represent significant step forward for both cross-sectarian reconciliation efforts and potential anti-AQI alliances as well as help further illuminate Sadr's political agenda.

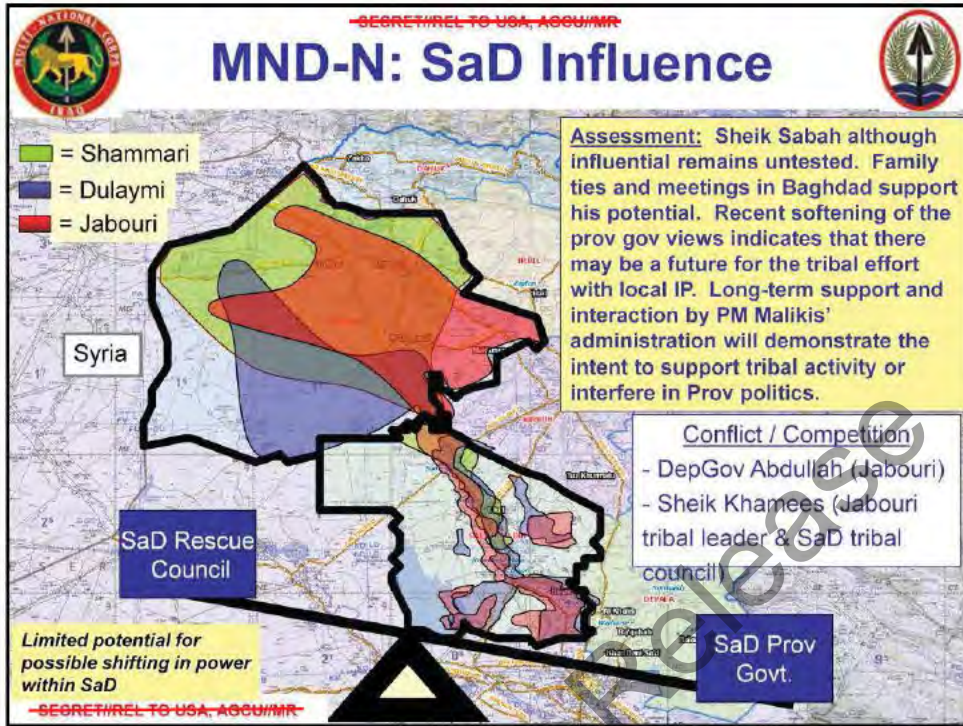
