### CCJ-3 TASKER: ARCENT ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

**Purpose:** To provide information to the Joint Staff pertaining to the Roles and Responsibilities of Army Central Command (ARCENT) / Combined Forces Land Component Command.

**Discussion:** ARCENT conducts Theater Security Cooperation activities, provides Title 10 Executive Agent support to deployed U.S. & Coalition forces, theater sustainment/CJRSOI support to CJTF-4a and support as appropriate to CJTF-1.4a. ARCENT key roles include the following:

- Provides support to ongoing operations in the CENTCOM AOR. Concurrently, maintains a forward-based capability to organize, plan, and provide "on-order" C2 for joint/combined land combat operations across the USCENTCOM AOR.
- Support to CJTF-4a and CJTF-1.4a. ARCENT support focuses on coalition and joint RSOI, theater sustainment activities, force rotational movements, and Kuwait battlespace management. ARCENT remains trained and ready to plan, set theater conditions, and execute future land component command missions or campaigns in support of the CENTCOM CDR.
  - CJFLCC/ 3rd Army/ARCENT (Forward) Hqs in Kuwait coordinates and executes all current operational requirements.
  - CJFLCC/ 3rd Army/ARCENT (Rear) Hqs in Atlanta plans, coordinates and trains for future operations and exercises.
- Provides common situational awareness, training and deployment readiness activities.
- As the Army Service Component Command, also provides support to other services. Currently ARCENT is supporting the Expeditionary Strike Group from NAVCENT.
- Validates all Army requirements in theater for both CJTF-4a and CJTF-1.4a AOR.

**Recommendation:** Continue ARCENT roles and responsibilities as presently defined.
