

Sir – Notes for MNC-I BUA, 29 Oct 07:

### CG Comments

1.4c

- During IGFC update, re: 14 IA Div – LTG Odierno does not think 14 IA Div has assumed any battlespace yet. Answer: IGFC briefer said he would check on it.
- During MND-N update, re: CLC friendly fire incident – LTG Odierno reinforced MND-N intent to get hold of the Sheik and ensure he understands how important proper equipment and positioning is for the CLC. The contracts are specific on weapons, uniform, and where they are employed.
- During the MND-N update, re: kidnap of Sheiks – LTG Odierno commented to be sure there is good coordination between MND-N and MND-B. MNC-I will work through that in 3 channels.
- During MNF-W update – LTG Odierno said, “Continuing our previous conversation; I’ll continue to work that but you’ll need to ID the unit you want to conduct that mission in case I can’t turn it around.”
- During MND-SE update – LTG Odierno asked to find out what Gen Jalil needs MNC-I to do to help get the ISF out of the prisons.
- Post-BUA comments – BG Anderson reviewed taskers:

- IGFC, C3 ISF, MND-SE – Find out 14 IA status in Basrah.
- All units, particularly MND-N – Review CLC contracts for uniform, weapons, and other requirements.
- C3 – Work through the coordination between MND-N and MND-B
- MNF-W – Work the 327 [MNF-W LNO believes it refers to 3/2/7 IA] replacement issue.

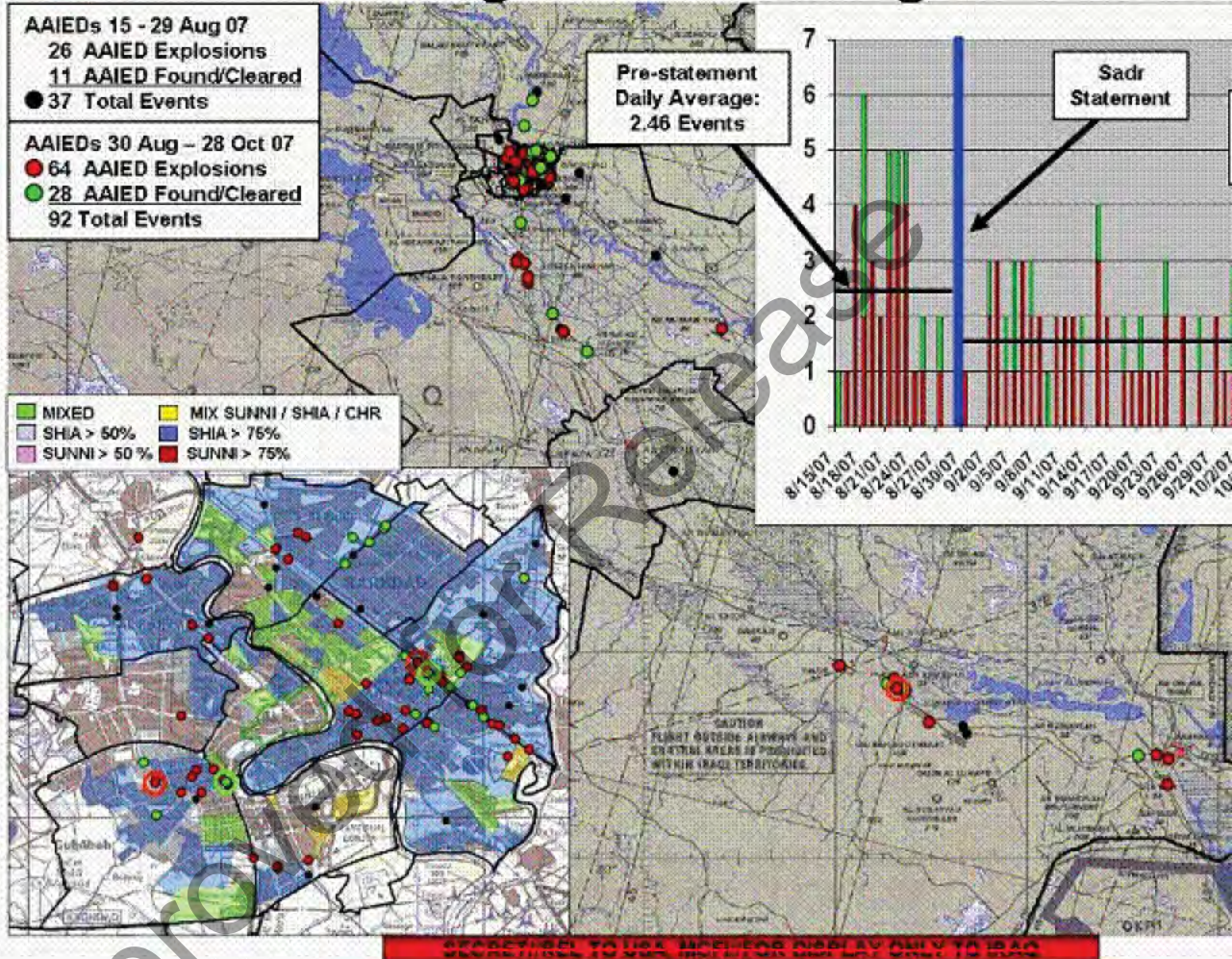
- IED and AAIED attacks preceding and following Al Sadr's order to JAM to cease attacks on Coalition Forces.

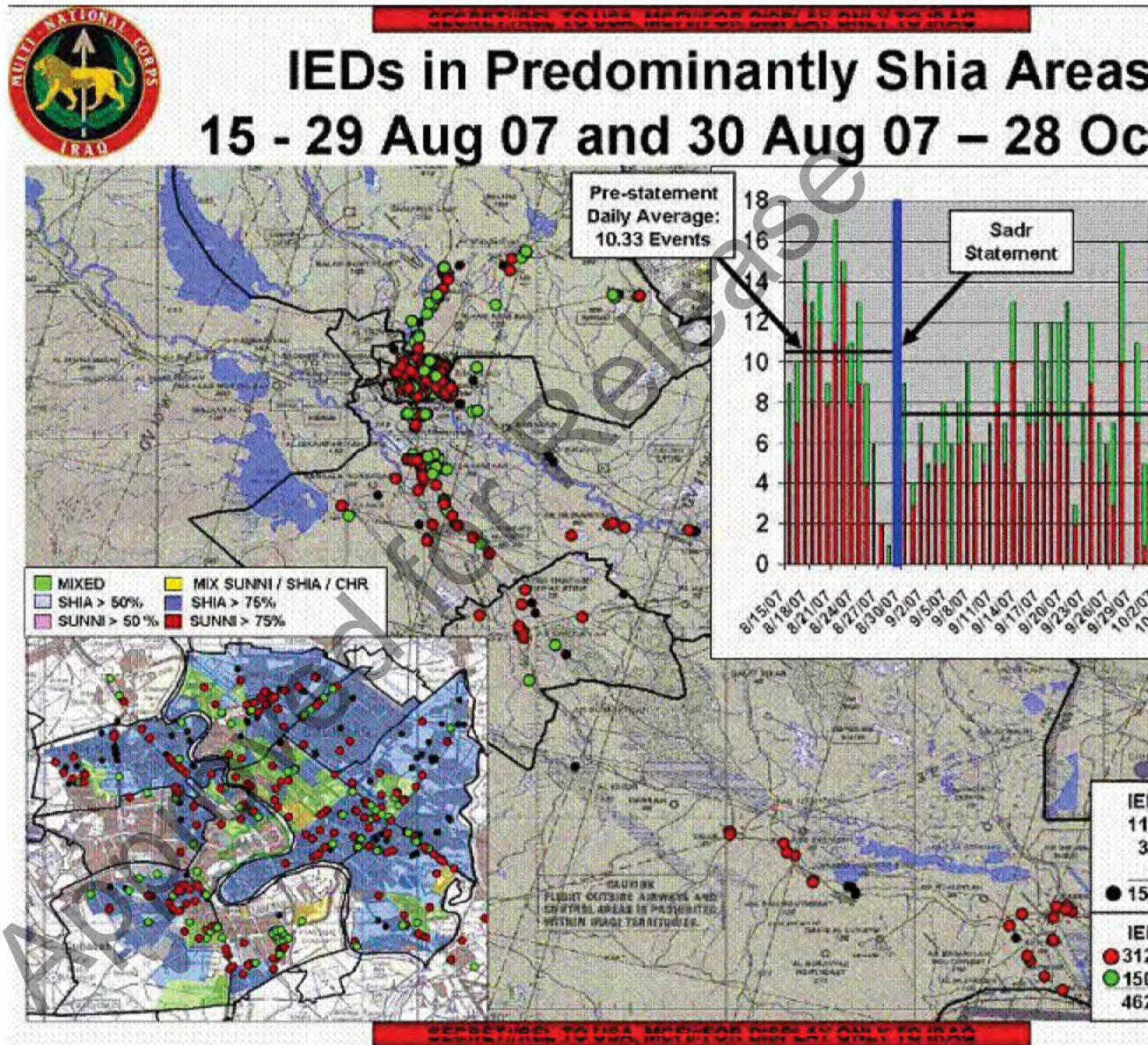
# AAIEDs

## 15 - 29 Aug 07 and 30 Aug 07 – 28 Oct



- During the two weeks preceding the 29 AUG announcement, AAIED attacks were occurring at a daily average of 2.5 events per day. Since the announcement, there have been 92 total AAIED attacks. This equates to a daily average of 1.5 events per day. There was an increase in activity during the first weeks of OCT, but has slowed over the past week. Compared to the September total of 54 AAIED attacks, there have been 50 attacks to date in October, with projected monthly totals in the Mid 50s. AAIED attacks since Thursday's BUA show an additional ring around the Icon. This week, there were two events on RTE Pluto between Rusafa and New Baghdad, and two events in W. Rashid. There was also one explosion in MND-SE.
- Of note is the continued decrease or lack of AAIED attacks in MND-CS and SE compared to previous months.

- The second slide depicts all IED attacks in Shia areas, or that are attributed to Shia extremists. There were 155 IED attacks from 15 to 29 August, for a daily average of 10.3. Since then, IED attacks have occurred at a daily rate of approximately 7.7, correlating with decreasing IED attack trends throughout the ITO.






- Despite IED attack declines, JAM Special Groups are still actively targeting Coalition Forces within Baghdad using AAIED's. It is unlikely that recent substantial cache finds will have a large impact on future attack rates. However, other operational and political factors may cause further noticeable changes in the number of AAIED attacks.
