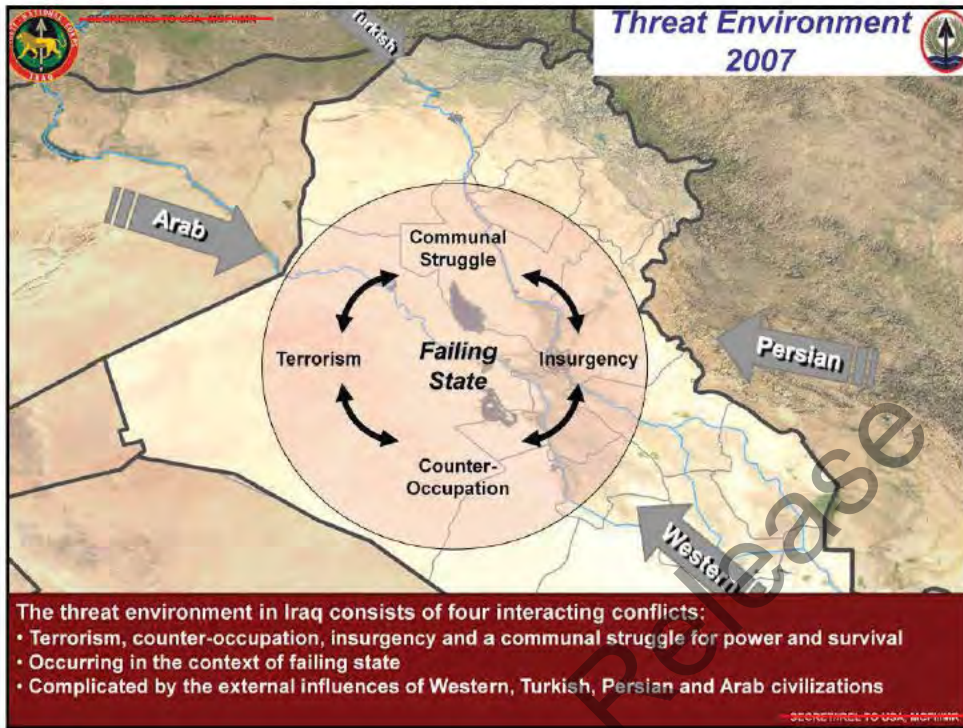
This conference affords an opportunity and forum to present Engagement IPB of each area in order to support MNC-I's Engagement and Reconciliation efforts

Intel supports Engagement and Reconciliation by:

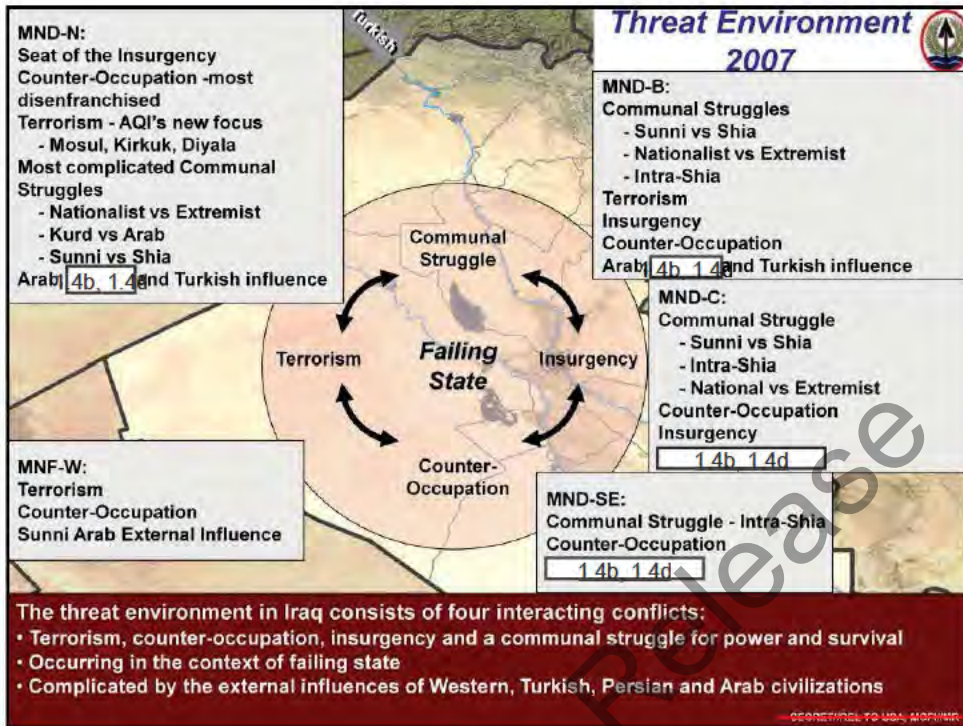
- Developing an environmental understanding of the context in which engagements take place

Outcome of this conference: Better understanding of how the MNDs' environments are inter-related in order to ensure our Engagement and Reconciliation efforts are mutually supporting

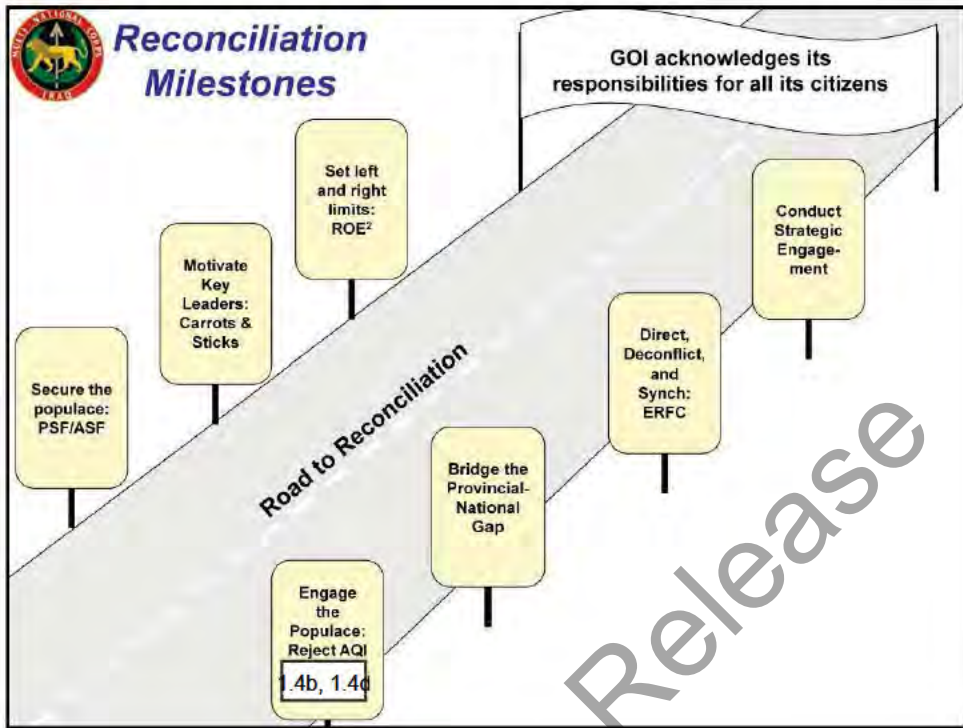
