**MISSION:** ON 06 FEB 08, 2/8/1-75 CAV CONDUCTED AREA RECONNAISSANCE WEST OF GHAZALIYAH TO FIND CACHES.

**TASK:** CONDUCT AREA RECONNAISSANCE TO FIND LOCATION OF SUSPECTED CACHES.

**PURPOSE:** THE PURPOSE OF THIS OPERATION IS TO DISRUPT AQI LOGISTICAL OPERATIONS IOT IMPROVE SECURITY IN WESTERN BAGHDAD.

**MISSION ACCOMPLISHMENT:** ON 06 FEB 08, 2/8/1-75 CAV CONDUCTED AREA RECONNAISSANCE WEST OF GHAZALIYAH WHEN PATROL FOUND REFRIGERATOR WITH CACHED WEAPON SYSTEMS BURIED IN THE BERM. UNIT CONTACTED EOD AND WHILE ESTABLISHING CORDON AND ALERTING AREA RESIDENTS FOR FIRST BLAST, THE UNIT IDENTIFIED A SECOND CACHE, APPROXIMATELY 200 METERS WEST, ALSO BURIED IN A REFRIGERATOR.

**POLITICAL IMPACT:** THE DISCOVERY OF THIS CACHE WILL DENY AQI DISTRIBUTION OF ITEMS THROUGHOUT BAGHDAD. ADDITIONALLY, FINDING OF THIS CACHE SHOWS THE POPULACE IN THIS RURAL AREA THAT COALITION FORCES CONTINUE TO MAINTAIN PRESENCE IN THE AREA TO DENY AQI FREEDOM OF MANEUVER.

## MND(SE) – SECURITY SUCCESSES

**IED** – On 8 Feb at 17:46hrs a RFS C/S reported a SUSIED 2 km east of the COB. One x UKM was detained at the scene and taken to the BPF. Following the confirmation of the IED. EOD carried out 3 x controlled explosions and at 0509hrs the next morning reported that the IED was a large shaped charge of between 15-20kg of military explosive, mobile phone armed and PIR initiated.

**ROCKET RAILS** – 5 crudely welded angle iron rails with car-jack elevators were handed over to MND(SE) by IPS. WIS Comment: It is considered highly unlikely that the rails handed in were recovered from the scene of the previous days attack. There were no signs of use, mud or dust on the rails. An artillery shell was handed in at the same time, but it was not prepared for firing on the rails. The origin of the rails handed in is not clear.



**ROCKET RAIL RECOVERY** – At 070526CFEB08 J1 (UK) EOD were tasked to pickup 5 x ROCKET RAILS and 1 x 122mm Artillery shell from the IPS at PVCP (A). Items are secured at Camp ALPHA the arrival of WIS. There were no MNF casualties or damage to report.

**ROCKET RAIL FIND** – On 10 Feb at 17:10hrs. PABT AIR identified 4 Rocket rails 14 km south of the COB to the SW of Baqra. Gun engaged the target with 6 x HE rounds and an F18 dropped 2 x 500lb bombs on the target. At 1840hrs following BDA the rails were declared destroyed. There were no MNF casualties or damage to report.

## CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS

**ENEMY SITUATION:** RECENT REPORTING INDICATES THAT HOUSES IN THE ALBU ALI JASSIM TRIBE HAVE BEEN USED AS LOCATIONS FOR THE ILLEGAL SALES OF IRAQI POLICE WEAPONS. THESE ARE ALSO THE APPARENT HOMES OF IRAQI POLICE FROM NEIGHBORING STATIONS. THE RECENT ATTACKS ON 19 JAN 08 IN ALBU OBAID ALSO INDICATE THAT THE ENEMY HAS BEEN ATTEMPTING REENTER THE JAZEERA AREA.

**MISSION:** CONDUCT COMBINED IP LED CLEARING OPERATION IN ALBU ALI JASSIM ON 6 FEB 08 TO DISRUPT THE AIF CELL AND FACILITATORS IN ORDER TO PREVENT AQI AND OTHER INSURGENT GROUPS FROM STAGING, PLANNING, AND EXECUTING FUTURE ATTACKS IN JAZEERA.

- CLEAR IN ZONE (ALBU ALBU ALI JASSIM) - "NONKINETIC"
- CONDUCT ORDNANCE/CACHE CLEARANCE OPERATIONS.

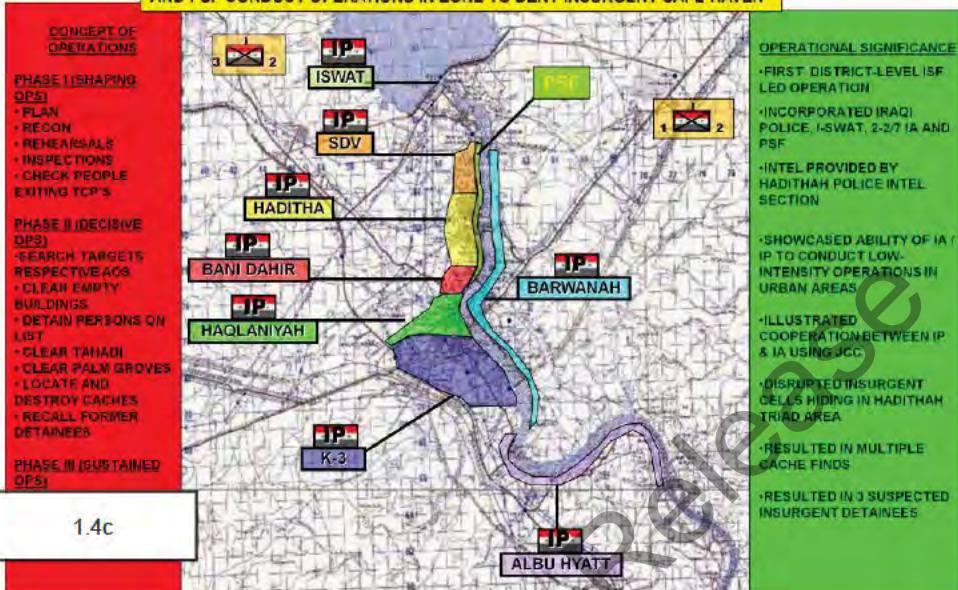



<p><b>Accomplished Mission:</b> E 1.4a provided Humanitarian Assistance to Abu Jamil 38S MC 681a, 1234a, 1. 4-2 SBCT provided supplies to the local populace while winning hearts and minds.</p>		<p><b>Political Impact:</b> The attitudes of the UN's in this village were positive towards CF/IA/PC. The UN's felt that the area has become much more secure in the last month than it was previously. IA soldiers appeared to share these feelings of security in this village.</p>
<p><b>Issues:</b> Electricity was out in the town (cut off by Al Qaeda two months prior to this operation). All news into the town was gained by word-of-mouth and cell phone. 1 in 3 households had a cell phone. Local Government does a once or bi-monthly food drop for villagers with ration cards. Locals proudly reported kicking four families of Shia out of their village. The village has no Muezzin. The last one was Shia and the town is planning on voting in a new one, but they did not know who it would be. CLCs (four total) and villagers are not communicating threats between them, and CLCs do not have contact with their contractor. The local gas station has not had fuel since the invasion. This town had one water source, a recently dug well.</p>		<p><b>4-2 SBCT PIR Answered:</b> Where are AQZ sanctuaries, training areas, and weapons caches that, if destroyed or captured, will degrade their operations? <b>Logistic Issues:</b> CLCs have requested MESCO barriers for the village.</p>

<p><b>WHAT WAS THOUGHT:</b> ACI will likely fight a delaying action to facilitate their exit from Abu Jamil and Duweib. Expect an enemy engagement zone just south of CP 472. Utilizing heavy machine gun fire and may also use IEDs to slow CF elements. ACI will likely conduct heavy attacks on the vehicle capable bridge over the canal at 385 (ACI's main attack) will likely include smaller (not large tanks) IEDs and SAM from rooftops, courtyards and windows from the west. ACI may exit from this area to the west into the palm groves in an attempt to avoid CF attack aviation. Any ACI still fighting CF south of the bridge will be doing so to facilitate further retreat south. Delaying IEDs will likely be employed on RTE Gold south of CP480 and along RTE Penguins east and south of Duweib.</p> <p><b>ASSESSMENT:</b> After the clearance operation conducted recently, CF have reduced the number of caches and IED's in the area. The local populace likely feel a sense of gratitude towards CF for providing a safer place to live in. With the aid that has been provided, the people likely will show their appreciation to CF. As the CF continue to aid the town and establish a foothold there, the people will be more receptive and willing to give information, thereby creating a conducive environment for gulling out of April ISF personnel and keep them out.</p> <p><b>BOTTOM LINE:</b> Without constant ISF presence in the area, this well orchestrated and actioned operation will do little to cease EFP activity in the Sulim and Imari ways area.</p>
