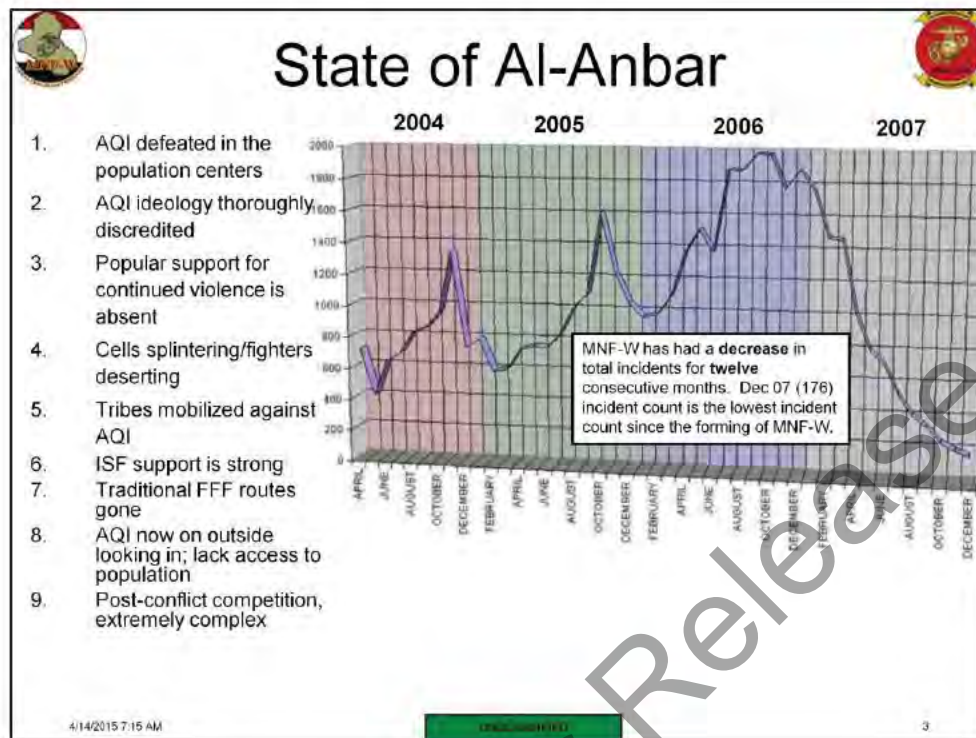

Risks to Progress in '08



1. Perceived national sectarian bias that impacts provincial and national cooperation
2. Lack of provision of basic services that undermines provincial and municipal government credibility
3. Violent political competition between provincial competitors
4. Economic stagnation that provides little capacity for additional civilian employment
5. Heavy CF presence in population centers that fuels nationalist perception of occupation

Limited fuel and continued interrupted power hinder additional growth, especially for our SOEs

- Poor Ministry of Agriculture implementation leaves warehouses full of useful material, grain, medicine.
 - Sheep/goat population face catastrophic losses because of drought and medicine & grain shortages.
- Poor Iraqi communication systems exacerbate linkage and coordination problems between municipal and provincial governments.
- Hold backs include Central Bank reluctance to institute progressive processes and to allow increased private banking operations.
 - Growing microfinance addresses this problem
