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Assessment: Highlighted areas contain AQIZ members, meeting locations and safe houses. In Muhalla 836 there are two TWJ member locations in vic. of AQIZ and AJAQ.

Recommendation: Areas should be cordoned before conducting clearing operations to hinder ACF from evading CF actions.



SOUTHEAST DOURA:

Assessment – Fighting has begun over the last few weeks between competing Sunni groups, AQIZ and the emerging Al Jurah Al Qaeda (AJAQ.) AJAQ is led by Dr. Isma-il Alwan Al-ithawi; yet the purpose and focus of his group is unknown. If fighting continues between the two groups expect attacks from AQIZ, which were focused on CF, to decrease within the AO as they weight their effort toward defeating AJAQ. Attacks against CF as a whole will not decrease, as Dr. Isma-il is an imam with a high amount of influence in the area and a heavy anti-CF rhetoric. Sunni elements are continuing to funnel weapons into the area via the Tigris River. Sunni supply lines move north along and up the river from the southern Sunni belt. A causeway from a canal IVO (GRID) is a likely location for Sunni insurgents to move their supplies out of the river and along the canal banks or small dirt tracks north east toward Baghdad.

CENTRAL DOURA:

Assessment – Sunni elements are continuing to utilize sewage treatment plant within the area as a means of staging weapons until such time as they forward deploy them to out-lying caches. We [redacted] it tak 24-4 h rs for supplies to be distributed from the Sewage treatment plant to outlin smaller caches. [redacted] 1.4c

[redacted] 1.4c [redacted] 1.4c It is likely supplies remain in these smaller caches until they are needed for attacks, then they will be move up n o the city. Expect ACF to visit these caches more than once in the 3 weeks between attacks. The last snapshot of high activity was taken on 26 August 2007. Another supply RTEs being used by Sunni elements is a small docking station [redacted] 1.4a located on the Tigris River. Activity suggests weapons movement between Karadah and Doura. Current y Sunni have a small collection of caches located on the Western side of the river.

Recommendation – CF should focus patrols in/around sewage treatment facility during the hours of 2100-0500z in an attempt to mitigate use of the facility. [redacted] 1.4c

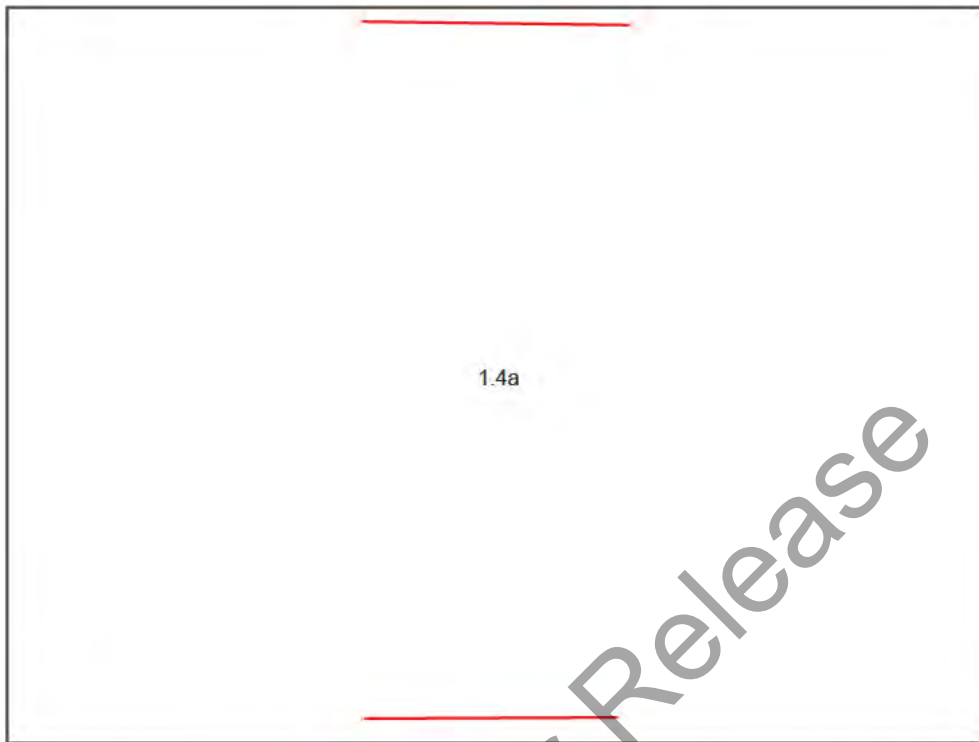
NORTHWEST DOURA:

Assessment – Sectarian violence has been very focused in this region based on large Sunni neighborhoods. Shia elements continue to target these populated areas with IDF/DF/EJK in an attempt to push Sunni LN out of the area. Actions directed against CF in this area have been primarily focused in 3 separate locations. Locations include; site focused on CPA [redacted] 1.4a south of RTE SENATORS along RTE BUICK, IED focused between RTE IRISH & RTE REDWINGS along RTE SENATORS/PREDATOS and along RTE REDWING between COP AZTEC and RTE PREDATORS. These focuses of attacks against CF are due to limited RTEs within the AO. CF are forced

to travel 3 main RTEs which allows ACF to focus combat power more effectively.

Recommendation – CF should continue clear/hold operation within Muhalla 820/822/824/826 to hinder Shia elements from continuing sectarian based attacks within the AO. Once CF stop sectarian based attacks in the northern Muhallas Sunni LN will be more inclined to assist CF in detaining AQLZ members. Suggest CF vary times and RTEs of convoys so as not to allow ACF to adjust to patterns. This step will significantly reduce number of CF casualties within the AO.

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The MDCOA reflects an increase in the Sectarian fighting in the Northwest populated area, as well as an increase in fighting between AJAQ and AQIZ over control of LOCs and Cache locations in Southeast Doura.

Additionally, IEDs that have been found and cleared may be an indication of a more developed defensive network put in place to prevent CF from raiding AQIZ caches in the area. There is no reporting to indicate this at this time; however, CF should be prepared for possible DBIEDs and prepared networks.

AQI Assessment

- ~~Will~~ AQI will not abandon Doura. AQI will attempt to stay low, reorganize, and wait for CF to leave area based on previous Shykh Clearing Operation. TTPs: AQI in Hadar is attempting to reorganize (OT) increase attack against CF.
- ~~Will~~ AQI will not live in Hadar on currently using the terrain. In Five Farms and Arab Jabour to avoid CF capture.
- ~~Will~~ AQI will still avoid to move limited amounts of personnel and material between North Doura, South Doura, and Arab Jabour.
- ~~Will~~ AQI groups that have retreated from Hadar during the initial clearing operations are most likely moving to reenter the AQ.

JAM Assessment

- ~~Will~~ JAM SG are currently posting into Hadar and attempting to fill the vacuum left by AQI. JAM SG will most likely increase attacks as CF operations begin to focus on JAM targets.
- ~~Will~~ JAM SG conduct attacks against CF using EFPs, snipers, SAE ambushes, and rocket IDF targeting FOB Falcon. Expect these attacks in response to CF actions against JAM.
- ~~Will~~ ~~Will~~ JAM is killing, intimidating, and removing Sunni LNs in Munafaa 360 with the assistance of terrorist IS and IF checkpoints. AQI cause disruption and deal AQI from Hadar.
- ~~Will~~ JAM will continue to conduct retaliatory attacks against CF as CF continues to conduct raids against JAM leadership.

DOURA EMILCOA:

~~Will~~ In the next month, expect AQI to attempt to continue to maintain Doura as a foothold in Baghdad. As CF continues to conduct clearing operations in M822, expect AQI to shift efforts into M820. AQI will also reseed themselves in Hadar as CF operations continue to move through Masafes. Expect AQI to expand their influence into Bayaa by displacing Shia LNs and conducting attacks against LNs in the Saydyah area. AQI will continue to move supplies through the area from Arab Jabour and the Five Farms area. Expect Shia elements in Abu T-Shir to exploit the situation by moving north from M850 into Hadar while AQI is weakened and preoccupied with CF. Shia elements will displace Sunni LNs in Hadar and conduct EJKs with the help of IF influence in the area in order to force Sunnis to flee.

Doura Overview: Over the last 48 hours, activity in Doura consisted of 4 x Caches found/cleaned, 1 x SAF, 2 x UXO, and 1 x Grenade. The AQI grenade attack in M822 targeted a CF dismounted patrol and led to the confiscation of a cache consisting of HMF, (b)(6) remain heavily reliant on HMF due to CF interdiction of supplies/railines into Doura. (b)(6) reporting indicates that AQI and JAM have continued to infiltrate the ISV recruitment since. Two AQI weapons traffickers were detained by CF in M808.	
Overall Assessment: In the next 24-48 hours, AQI will continue to sustain operations by recruiting, shifting Foreign Fighters into the area, and re-supplying caches throughout Doura. In Maslee, AQI will continue to establish caches in preparation of future attacks. In Hader, AQI still maintains a significant presence in M848. AQI will continue to conduct grenade, SAF and heavy IED attacks against CF IOTI and/or CF clearance operations. AQI and JAM will continue to conduct retaliatory EJKs against each other. ISV gain dominance over Hader, AQI and JAM will also continue to infiltrate the ISV and gather information. In Abu T'Shir, JAM SG will increase attacks due to recent reporting that indicates new shipments of supplies have entered the AQI.

Kinetic Mitigation:	
1. Reinforce presence in Hadar and Masafes. AQI reported intimidation expands North and East, but reporting decreases in central Hadar indicating AQI has regained control in central MASAF and MASAF.	
2. Reinforce presence in Arab Jabour. AQI will become more organized and establish C2 nodes. <ul style="list-style-type: none">- AQI leadership will reorganize efforts in Arab Jabour.- Increase targeting and coordinated attacks on GLCs.- Coordinated attacks will include simultaneous assaults on GLC CPs, while at the same time, attack and prolong IAF response time with an AQI band force.	1.4a

2SCR(-) conducts full spectrum COIN operations focused on the destruction of AQIZ in TOA Dragoon from 13 SEP – 15 OCT to enable 2nd Squadron to control AO Cougar (formerly TOA Dragoon) after 15 OCT.

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COMMANDER'S INTENT



PURPOSE: To enable 2-2 SCR to assume control of AO Cougar after the Regiment(-) has to displace into another BCT's OE on 15 OCT. To achieve this end, we will use 3-2 SCR as an above-ground force focused on the destruction of AQIZ and a subsequent area reconnaissance in the eastern TOA to provide a more accurate enemy template for prosecution. Simultaneously, 2-2 SCR will focus on the establishment and maintenance of its COPs and the development of relationships that will allow it to pursue reconciliation and a transfer of security responsibilities to the ISF and ISV.

KEY TASKS:

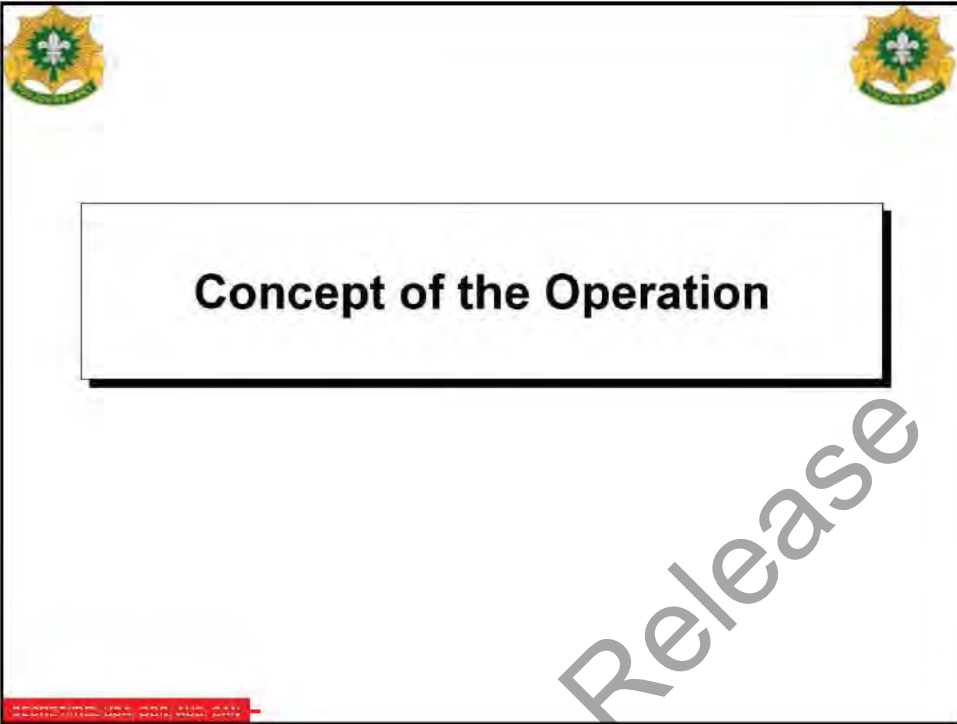
- Establish COP Cougar/JSS to deny enemy FOM VIC Saha
- Destroy AQIZ vic M834 and M836 to prevent AQIZ influence on the population in East Rashid
- Secure route Red Wings to protect CF FOM
- Conduct reconciliation to enable the population to begin the transition to self-security
- Monitor gas stations in TOA Dragoon to prevent JAM influence in gas sales
- Execute coordinated BHO from 3-2 SCR to 2-2 SCR to prevent enemy re-seeding and subsequent ability to influence populace

ENDSTATE: AQIZ is incapable of conducting sustained operations in TOA Dragoon and has a significantly reduced influence on the populace; 3-2 SCR is deployed to Khadamiya for follow-on operations and 2-2 SCR is prepared to assume control of AO Cougar and conduct effective COIN operations; AO Cougar is secured and CF FOM preserved
