



MNF-I RELEASE AND RETENTION TOPICS

COMBINED REVIEW AND RELEASE BOARD RELEASE RATE HAS DECLINED OVER TIME (TOTALS REFLECT MULTIPLE REVIEWS OF SOME FILES)

CRRB RELEASE RATE 2004 - 60% 2005 - 37% 2006 - 24%

- JOINT DETAINEE COMMITTEE RESULTS TO DATE 90.5% RETAINED / 9.5% RELEASED
- MAGISTRATE CELL RESEARCH AND REVIEW PROCESS HAS IMPROVED ...
 INCREASED MANNING, GREATER COMMUNICATION WITH CAPTURING UNITS, TRAINING TO IMPROVE QUALITY OF DETAINEE FILES, EMBEDDED INVESTIGATORS AT DIVISION LEVEL AND BELOW

DETENTION AND RELEASE STRATEGY

GENERAL POINTS:

- DETAIN THOSE WHO ARE THREATS. RELEASE THOSE WHO ARE NOT.
- PROVIDE DIV CDRS AUTHORITY TO APPROVE 21-DAY ISNS.
- CONTINUE TO ADHERE TO THE PROCESS OUTLINED IN CPA MEMORANDUM 3, CPA ORDER 99, AND MNF-I 11-1, CONSISTENT WITH THE GC IV REVIEW STANDARD.
- IMPROVE THE COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH PROCESS BETWEEN THE TF- 1.49 MAGISTRATE CELL, MNC-I SJA/PMO, AND THE CAPTURING UNIT TO RESOLVE QUESTIONS ON CASES TO ENSURE ADEQUATE INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE TO MAKE A REASONED DECISION.
- CONTINUE TO DETAIN THOSE ASSESSED AS THREATS DESPITE BEING RECOMMENDED FOR RELEASE BY THE CRRB/JDRC OR DISMISSED BY THE CCCI.
- ADJUST THE TIMING OF CRRB RELEASES (UNIT/MNF-I C2 VETTED) AND COURT DISMISSALS TO MEET OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS.

INTERNAL COUNTERINSURGENCY CONCEPT

Goals...

- Disrupt Extremist Operations inside compounds (recruiting, religious conversion, networking, training...)
- Negate message of extremists
- Deter violence, riots, and escapes

Key Supporting Tasks...

- Establish an S2, CI and Cultural Adviser team per compound
- Identify recruiters, religious converters,
 Sharia court members ... and make appropriate moves to disrupt their efforts
 - Conduct an information campaign using radio TV and newspapers, prominent speakers...to accurately portray the changes in Iraq and need for national unity
- Employ methods to disrupt illicit communications between compounds
- Identify and employ older mentor detainees
- Conduct visual exercises that demonstrate capacity to deal with violence
- Execute a patrol and observation plan that prevents escapes
- Increase frequency of full inspections of compounds



Camp Cropper COIN Strategy






Special Population - AQIZ-linked




Special Population - JAM-linked

EDUCATION PROGRAM

Goals...

- Teach all illiterate detainees to read and write basic Arabic and possess basic math skills
- Provide all detainees classes on the Iraqi Constitution, composition of COR, life in a democratic state
- Provide positive option against extremist influence in compounds
- Develop basic skills to support an improved level of employment
- Maintain positive focus for juveniles

RELIGIOUS EXTREMIST REHAB PROGRAM

Goals...

- Convert select extremists to a more logical set of beliefs through religious instruction, discussions, counseling...
- Provide incentive for extremists to seek other options
- Develop program GOI can introduce into their Prison System
- Develop a conceptual understanding of extremists for use by other US agencies
- Increase actionable intelligence against AQIZ cells
- Develop AQIZ IO counter-initiatives

PEOPLES MOJAHEDIN OF IRAN (MeK)

- ESTABLISHED IN 1960S AS AN ANTI-SHAH ORGANIZATION EVOLVED INTO AN ANTI-IRANIAN REGIME GROUP IN THE 1980S
- MOVED TO IRAQ IN MID-1980S AND USED BY SADDAM IN IRAN-IRAQ WAR
- SIGNED AN AGREEMENT WITH THE US IN 2003, TURNED IN THEIR LARGE WEAPONS, CONSOLIDATED AT ASHRAF
- ESTABLISHED AS PROTECTED PERSONS UNDER GENEVA CONVENTION IV BY THE US IN 2004
- ON US AND EUROPEAN TERRORIST ORGANIZATION LISTS
- US BATTALION PROVIDES SECURITY MEK THREATENED BY SHIA EXTREMISTS
- APPROXIMATELY 200 DEFECTORS IN ADJACENT DEFECTOR CAMP 178 HAVE RECEIVED DEFECTOR STATUS FROM UNHCR BUT NO HOST COUNTRIES HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED
- PM MALIKI STATED IN AUG 06 THAT THEY MUST DEPART IRAQ COMPLEX SITUATION WITH NO EASY SOLUTION
