





ALL VBIEDS OCCURRED 25-28 DEC (THOUGH ANOTHER REPORTED THIS MORNING IN NAJAF). THIS "SPIKE" SEEMS TO CONFIRM [REDACTED] TREND ANALYSIS

MURDERS DECREASED SIGNIFICANTLY, POSSIBLY DUE TO POOR WEATHER KEEPING POTENTIAL VICTIMS OFF THE STREETS.

BAGHDAD EAGLE WAS AN IA IN THE LEAD OPERATION WHICH DETAINED 30 INCLUDING 14 ON THE 4/6 HVI LIST.


[REDACTED] FIFTH OPERATION IN GHAZALIYAH IN 6 DAYS AND SEVENTH IN TWO WEEKS. THROUGHOUT THE AOR, MND-B CONDUCTED 1 BDE SIZE OPERATIONS (ARROWHEAD STRIKE 2), 5 BATTALION SIZE OPERATIONS (INCLUDING ONE IA-IN-THE-LEAD), AND 11 COMPANY SIZE OPERATIONS (INCL ONE IA-IN-THE-LEAD). MOST OPERATIONS WERE COMBINED. 23 CACHES WERE FOUND AND CLEARED. ENEMY BDA INCLUDED 25 KIA AND 175 DETAINED. THERE WERE 18 CF KIA AND 62 CF WIA, 2 NBD AND 4 NBI.

NEW BAGHDAD RESIDENTS BELIEVE THERE IS MOI COMPLICITY INVOLVED IN JAM MURDERS OF RELEASED IP/NP DETAINEES.




Operation Tiger was an IA in the lead operation in Adhamiyah

<p>Narrative: Commencing 01 JAN 07, Task Force 1.4a clears Huriya. IOW TF 1.4a (211 ID) to disrupt AIF/Militia activity, deny urban support zones and set conditions for IIND-B decisive operations. I/O respond rapidly to emergent situations and clear designated areas (Shehab/U) to enable control/retention by Coalition and Iraq Security Forces.</p> <p>Political Impact: AIF/JAM forces surprised and unable to respond with any lethal or non-lethal effects. JAM appears to be thoroughly disrupted in Huriya. Operations conducted without issues. The IA continued to perform thorough searches.</p>	8
