

LEAD TO ACTIONABLE INTELLIGENCE ON WEAPONS AND OTHER CELLS OF NON-COMPLIANT INDIVIDUALS. LIKEWISE, THERE IS A RISE IN THE NUMBER OF IRAQIS WILLING TO COME FORWARD WITH INFORMATION ON WEAPONS CACHE AND SUBVERSIVE ACTIVITIES. FORMER REGIME LOYALIST, TERRORIST AND CRIMINALS REMAIN A THREAT TO OUR FORCES AND THE SECURITY OF THE IRAQI POPULACE, BUT WE HAVE SEEN NO INDICATION OF ANY NATIONAL LEVEL ORGANIZATION OF THESE THREATS. WE CONTINUE TO SEE NON-COMPLIANT FORCES USING INTIMIDATION AGAINST IRAQI LEADERS AND INDIVIDUALS ASSISTING THE COALITION. THE ABILITY TO PROVIDE FUEL AND ELECTRICAL POWER REMAINS ONE OF THE PRIMARY CONCERNS IN ESTABLISHING A STABLE ENVIRONMENT. THE DIFFICULTY PROVIDING POWER AND FUEL ARE COMPOUNDED BY ATTACKS ON THE INFRASTRUCTURE AND DAMAGE DONE BY LOOTERS. WE CONTINUE TO WORK WITH IRAQI LEADERS AND THE CPA TO FIND BOTH SHORT-TERM AND LONG-TERM SOLUTIONS TO THESE PROBLEMS AND HAVE MADE PROGRESS IN SOME AREAS. 3.E.2.A. (S/REL USA GRR AUS CAN) 1ST AD: WITH OPERATION GREEN SHIELD IN MOTION, 1AD PLANS TO DESTROY AND CAPTURE ENEMY MORTAR AND ROCKET SYSTEMS ATTEMPTING TO FIRE ON THE GREEN ZONE. IT IS WITH OPERATIONS SUCH AS THIS; WE INTEND TO DISRUPT THE ENEMY FROM PLANNING ATTACKS ON COALITION FORCES. ANOTHER EXAMPLE OF OUR PLANS TO DISRUPT THE ENEMY WAS IN ZONE 26 LAST NIGHT, IN WHICH ELEMENTS OF 2/82 CONDUCTED A RAID; THEY AN INDIVIDUAL SUSPECTED OF BEING A (b)(6) MEMBER OF A TERRORIST CELL. ALSO IN ZONE 69, 2BCT CONDUCTED A RAID IN WHICH THEY CAPTURED, (b)(6) HAD A 2002 FEDAYEEN ID CARD, ALSO CONFISCATED (2) AK 47, (2) 9MM, AND 1 BAYONET.

(S/BEL USA GBR AUS CAN) 82ND ABN: THE DIVISION CONTINUES COMBAT OPERATIONS THROUGHOUT OUR BATTLESPACE TO PROVIDE A SECURE ENVIRONMENT FOR THE IRAQI PEOPLE AND COUNTER ON-GOING EFFORTS BY FRLS AND TERRORISTS TO DISRUPT COALITION AND IRAQI SECURITY OPERATIONS. OUR COMBAT POWER REMAINS GREEN OVERALL. FALLUJAH, KHALIDIYAH, HUSAYBAH AND ARE THE MOST HOSTILE AREAS TO COALITION FORCES IN OUR AO AND EACH OF OUR MSCS REMAINED FOCUSED IN THESE AREAS. WE CONTINUE TO DEVELOP ISR TRIGGERS AND A CONPLAN TO ISOLATE AND CLEAR ANTI-COALITION FORCES FROM FALLUJAH. WE MAINTAIN CONTINUOUS COMBAT PATROLLING ALONG MAIN SUPPLY ROUTES THROUGHOUT THE ZONE TO DETECT AND DETER THE EMPLACEMENT OF IEDS AND DISRUPT AMBUSHES. CURRENCY EXCHANGES AND GOVERNMENT SALARY PAYMENTS CONTINUE THROUGH THE ZONE WITHOUT INCIDENT AND WE CONTINUE TO RECEIVE POSITIVE RECEPTION FROM THE LOCAL POPULACE AND LEADERSHIP. TODAY WE GRADUATED 45 POLICE CADETS AT THE AL ANBAR POLICE ACADEMY IN AR RAMADI. OUR 3RD ICDC CLASS CONTINUES TO TRAIN AT THE NAVEA TRAINING CENTER WITH 171 RECRUITS. WE REMAIN PREPARED TO RESPOND IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE LOCAL POLICE TO INCIDENTS DURING RAMADAN. WE ARE WORKING CLOSELY WITH LOCAL LEADERS, AND SECURITY FORCES TO FACILITATE THE YEAR-END TRANSITION OF SECURITY OPERATIONS TO THE IRAQI PEOPLE THAT WILL FREE OUR COMBAT POWER TO FOCUS ON CAPTURING OR KILLING ELEMENTS THAT DISRUPT THE STABILITY AND SECURITY OF IRAQ. INTELLIGENCE REVIEW OF AO. ACTIONS AFTER THE ATTACK AGAINST FOB ATTACK RESULTED IN 6 DETAINEES. THE ATTACK SOUTH OF LSA ANACONDA RESULTED IN 1 FRIENDLY WIA AND 1 ENEMY KIA. THERE WERE FIVE INDIRECT FIRE CONTACTS DIRECTED AGAINST FOB ANIMAL, FOB DANIELS, FOB TINDERBOX AND 2 ATTACKS AGAINST THE SAMARRA CMOC. THE ATTACKS RESULTED IN NO INJURIES OR DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT. THERE WERE FOUR IED INCIDENTS IN THE TE AO. TWO OF THE IEDS DETONATED AND 2 WERE DISCOVERED PRIOR TO DETONATION. THE 2 IEDS THAT WERE DISCOVERED BEFORE DETONATION WERE LOCATED BY AN IRAQI POLICE PATROL IN YASIN SU'UD, AND AN IRAQI POLICE PATROL IN MUQDADIYAH. THE TWO IEDS THAT WERE DETONATED WERE EMPLACED IN THE CITY OF TIKRIT, WHICH SEVERELY INJURED THE ATTACKER AND CAUSED MINOR INJURIES TO A CPA OFFICER; AND IN BAQUBAH, WHICH CAUSED 4 FRIENDLY WIAS. DURING THIS PERIOD, TASK FORCE 1.4a CONDUCTED EIGHT RAIDS. ALL EIGHT OF THE RAIDS WERE CONDUCTED BY 2BCT. RAIDS TARGETED THE TURKOMEN HQ IN KIFRI, THE COMMUNIST HQ IN KIFRI, SUSPECTED WEAPONS DEALERS, A SUSPECTED TED MAKER, A SUSPECTED LEADER OF A TERRORIST CELL, A TERRORIST SUSPECTED OF CONDUCTING ATTACKS AGAINST COALITION FORCES, AND A SUSPECTED MORTAR ATTACKER. THE RAIDS RESULTED IN 10 DETAINEES, INCLUDING 4 TARGETS. THE RAIDS ALSO RESULTED IN THE CONFISCATION OF A LARGE VARIETY OF SMALL ARMS AND AMMUNITION. THERE WERE TWO CONTACTS WITH MINES, THE MINES WERE LOCATED BY A PATROL IN BAYJI, WHICH SUBSEQUENTLY DESTROYED IT WITH DIRECT FIRE, AND BY A PATROL IN BA'QUBAH, WHICH WAS NEUTRALIZED BY EOD. TODAY WAS THE TWENTY-THIRD DAY OF THE TRAQI CURRENCY EXCHANGE WITH NO INCIDENTS. TF 1.4a MOVED APPROXIMATELY 29 PLS LOADS WORTH OF CEA AND DESTROYED APPROXIMATELY 13 PLS LOADS WORTH OF CEA. TF 1.4a CURRENTLY HAS IDENTIFIED 2012 PROJECTS ACROSS THE AOR. 545 OF THOSE ARE FUNDED, 1063 ARE COMPLETE, AND 407 PROJECTS ARE AWAITING FUNDS. IN 2BCT'S AO, 1-67 AR CONDUCTED A MEETING WITH HIB HIB AREA SHIEKS AT THE GOVERNOR'S BUILDING COVERING TOPICS OF ICDC RECRUITING, A POSSIBLE MEETING WITH LOCAL TMAMS, HIB HIB SECURITY ISSUES, POLICE NEEDS, A NEW GOVERNMENT BUILDING IN AL GHALEBIYA, FUEL ISSUES, AND REPRESENTATION ISSUES FOR MOKTARS. B/3-67 AR PROVIDED FORCE PROTECTION MATERIAL TO 3 POLICE STATIONS. THE POLICE STATIONS WERE IN AL ABHARRA, ZAGHANIYAH, AND ZAHRAH. B 3/67 DISTRIBUTED SAND BAGS AND CLASS IV MATERIALS. THE POLICE STATIONS WILL BUILD ESTABLISHED PERMANENT IPF CHECKPOINTS IN THE VIC OF AS SADAH. IN THE 173 AO, 80% OF SEWAGE PROJECTS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED WITH NO PROBLEMS REPORTED.

3.E.2.D. (S/REL USA GBR AUS CAN) 101ST AAD: A VERY ACTIVE 24 HOURS WITH SEVEN DIRECT FIRE CONTACTS, 4 IED INCIDENTS, AND 1 INDIRECT FIRE CONTACT. WE KILLED ONE ENEMY, AND DETAINED THREE MORE. SADLY, WE ALSO HAD ONE SOLDIER KILLED AND 10 WOUNDED. ONE OF THE SOLDIERS IS SERIOUSLY WOUNDED, BUT THE REMAINDER WILL LIKELY RETURN TO DUTY. THE IED INCIDENTS OCCURRED ACROSS THE AOR WITH ONE IN THE UPPER TIGRIS RIVER VALLEY, TWO IN MOSUL, AND ONE ON HWY 2 BETWEEN MOSUL AND IRBIL.

THE ENEMY ATTEMPTED TO AMBUSH A MOUNTED PATROL NEAR TALL AFAR AND ENGAGED COMPANY COMPOUNDS HERE IN MOSUL ON THREE OCCASIONS. IT IS HARD TO DETERMINE IF THESE SERIES OF ATTACKS WERE COORDINATED ACROSS THE AOR. THURSDAYS ARE GENERALLY THE MOST ACTIVE DAY IN TERMS OF ENEMY ACTIVITY, AND THE LAST 24 HOURS WAS THE MOST ACTIVE PERIOD SINCE JULY. WE HAD AN EXCELLENT JOINT OPERATION WITH SOF LAST NIGHT THAT CONTINUES TO REINFORCE OUR RELATIONSHIP AND OVERALL EFFECTIVENESS. IN THAT CONTACT, 2 BCT AND SOF ELEMENTS CONDUCTED A JOINT OPERATION TARGETING A HVT FACILITATOR. DURING THE COURSE OF ACTIONS IN THE TARGET HOUSE, THE TARGET THREW A GRENADE. THE TARGET WAS IMMEDIATELY SHOT AND KILLED, BUT THE EFFECTS OF THE GRENADE INJURED 2 CHILDREN AND A WOMAN. THERE WERE A TOTAL OF 4 MEN AND 23 WOMEN AND CHILDREN IN THE HOUSE. THE UNIT DETAINED THE 3 SURVIVING MALES, 1 OF WHICH WAS THE BROTHER OF THE TARGET, 1 WAS HIS NEPHEW AND ONE WAS NOT RELATED TO THE TARGET. THE THREE PRISONERS WHO WERE EVACUATED WILL LIKELY YIELD ADDITIONAL INFORMATION. THE REWARDS PROGRAM CONTINUES TO BUILD MOMENTUM. A HOTLINE CALLER TURNED IN 34 RPGS TO THE D-MAIN, AND YESTERDAY AFTERNOON, THE COALITION FOR IRAQI NATIONAL UNITY (CINU) TURNED IN 17 X RPG LAUNCHERS AND 2 X RPG ROUNDS AT A BATTALION TOC NEAR SINJAR. THIS IS THE 14TH TURN-IN FROM THAT ORGANIZATION. 113 NEW POLICE OFFICERS GRADUATED FROM OUR INTERIM POLICE ACADEMY AND THEY WILL BE EMPLOYED IMMEDIATELY HERE IN MOSUL CITY. THE ADDITIONAL POLICE WILL HAVE AN OBVIOUS POSITIVE IMPACT ON MAINTAINING A SECURE AND SAFE ENVIRONMENT. 3.E.2.E. (S/REL USA GRR AUS CAN) MND (SE): DIV GE ACROSS THE AO REMAINS GREEN.
