J5-Strategic Context/Shaping

- Internationally remain strong; SecState visiting TU to discuss HA and ground support
- 4ID continues to flow
- Cities are calmer
- Despicable acts, such as the woman shot on the bridge and a report of possible cyanide in wells
- Good show on the HA front, orderly distribution of HA in the south

J2

- C2 nodes: increase in the use of microwave, decrease in the number of high powered mobile phones being used; no change in the satellite and radio broadcasts
- Central
 - 2 armor Bdes of Nebuchadnezzar moving south; Medina relocating north; Baghdad div heavily damaged by coalition air; Al Nida remains unlocated, Hammarabi has 2 elements moving southeast to defend the southwest quadrant of Baghdad; Adnan has elements moving south into Hammarabi positions, oriented to the north and west; RA III Corps moving to the southeast; 3rd SF Bde unlocated
 - SFG heavy forces relocating within Baghdad for survival, moving into residential areas; RDSs patrolling the city
 - No increase of EW radar activity
 - No air activity
 - 2 GPS jammers, no effect
- South: no significant changes to RA dispositions; some movement north to Al Amarah
- 2 TSTs against IIS and Regime Relocation Site
- North: 1 Bde of Nebuchadnezzar ivo Kirkuk as a backstop, no significant changes to other forces
- Missiles: 71 unlocated; SSM launched from south of Baghdad, engaged by Patriot; 3 CSSC-3 from vicinity of Basrah, no damage or CBW
- Arab volunteers- up to 4,000 are being report by CNN and press; assess 300-600 per day are crossing the border into IZ

J-8 Assessment

- Good progress in many areas, no change to overall assessment

J-3 CDRs Guidance

- 1.4a, 1.4g
- CFLCC
- Started today with 2 corps attack into Baghdad division and conglomeration of the Medina, Al Nida, and Hammarabi at 0300Z; attack in zone in both areas over the next 72 hours
 - 1st UK zone- great BDA, over 100 tanks and 30 armored vehicles destroyed; enemy is reinforcing failure in Hwy 6 area; not much left of 51st and 6th Armor; continue ops in and around Basrah; 3 Commando sweep for CSSC-3 launchers; 16th AA in the oil fields
 - Put bombs on Hwy 6 to interdict it; one west of Al Kut made the road impassible, the east will be restruck and will be impassable too
 - Against the RDSs
 - North of An Nasiriyah RCT 1 attacked As Shatrah with 100 tribals, destroyed 2 Ba'ath Party hqtrs, got the upper hand there now; in An Nasiriyah the OGA says the raid tonight will break the back of RDS there; after the raid TF 1.4a will move north to do rear area security for 1st MarDiv; 15th MEU will remain in An Nasiriyah
 - In As Samawah the 82nd had good attacks, captured a general with a map with good information
 - 101s is working around An Najaf, recognizing the holy sites; good BDA against a Saddam Fedayeen training area
 - Next the line between Karbala, Al Hilliayah, Ad Diwaniyah, and Al Kut need to be worked
 - Concept of ops for attack
 - 1st MarDiv:
 - At 0300Z RCT-1 attacks up Hwy 7 towards Al Kut to make contact with the Baghdad division
 - RCT-5 attacks early evening to cross the Saddam Canal at An Numaniyah to cut Hwy 6
 - On order RCT-7 completes the isolation of the Baghdad in Al Kut
 - Destroys all Baghdad division elements
 - postured to continue attack into Al Nida 48-72-96 hours depending on the situation
 - V Corps conducts attack 2100Z after shaping

- 1st BCT attacks through the Karbala Gap, followed by 3rd BCT and div cav sqdn to the northwest
- 1st BCT moves through Obj Chargers to Obj Peach, which is a crossing on the Euphrates
- 2nd BCT attacks north to destroy the enemy in zone and secure Obj Saints; supported by CAS and arty
- 101st attacks on order to AO Eagle west of BIAP and BPT conduct air assault in the area later in the attack
- 82nd and rest of 101st work As Samawah area
- o In a couple of days should see 3ID across the Euphrates; destroyed- 2 Nebuchadnezzar infantry bdes, 2 bde of the Medina, some of the Hammarabi guarding to the northwest, and ready to commit the 101; destroyed what is in Al Kut and attack along Hwy 6 axis into Al Nida
- o In the south, work cities with OGA and tribals; 1st UK works Basrah, interdicts anything coming down Hwy 6, works 6th and 10th in Al Amarah

CFSOCC

- North
 - o SSE in Khurma continues, samples out tonight
 - o Green Line- IZ not attempting to push back in to early positions
 - o PR attempts on 2 TF4 members, no progress to date; find out what in that area of key contact
 - o Good work along Green Line with ODA and CAS; AC-130 worked too
 - o Meeting with Committee of 4 yesterday, will bring some fighters south
 - o No confirmation that letter was delivered to 1st Corps commander
 - o Planning to do strikes on D+15 unless told not to
 - o Anticipating 1st delivery of NSCVs from TU for JSOTF-N tonight
 - o Some confusions on runways at Bashur and Irbil- Bashur is in excellent shape; Irbil will accept C-17 but does not have TRANSCOM stamp of approval
 - o JSOTF-N infil continues
- West
 - o Continue with CFACC help to hit Ar Rutbah
 - o TF4 cleared bunker at H-2
 - o AC-130 worked VISOBs, radio tower, fiber cables, and buildings
 - o Good effects with AC-130s and DAPs
 - o Al Shatrah raid got potential HV detainees and good info
- South- more AC-130 work against SSMs, BMPs, and BRDMs; good work by NWSTG in counter RDS ops; support to CFLCC continues

CFACC

- Good day, 50 or so regime targets hit
- Hit 4 high CD targets, one needs restrike and must be done at night
- 7 targets/17 DMPIs in Baghdad last night
- CFLCC support- 241 sorties to V Corps, 256 to MEF, good work on the Hammarabi
- 12 sorties out of Tallil, increase from 6 yesterday
- Looking to see how to get shorted legged aircraft up closer
- Attrition of RG- good against the Medina and Baghdad, the others are next
- Dynamic targeting- biggest dynamic and TST day to date, CFACC, CFLCC and Centcom staffs working this well
- 8 radars struck last night
- In the West- looked for 2 troopers, had helos over the recovery site; not totally secure out in the west yet; pushing most BM stuff as far east as possible; covered 295 hide sites yesterday
- Air superiority- 3 SAMs shot yesterday- SA 2, SA 8, and ROLAND; 11 SAMs in 10 days fired; 62 DMPI against IADS in the emerging targets
- Going up against airfield again

CFMCC

- TLAM reload continues, did a dozen yesterday, going for 2 dozen today
- Tommy Franks Express all ahead flank
- Morale and readiness are high; green across the board
- 30 C TLAM models on ships in Med, plus some other models; keeping the shooters there due to possibility of permission to put TLAMs over TU

- Rangers secured Hadithah Dam; finished SSE; dam not rigged for demo; underground facility empty; 24 EPW, 20 KIA, 27 civilians in custody
- TF 1.4a is across Euphrates, 40% of the way to Obj ivo Tikrit
- Reinforcing H-1
- Good connectivity with TF 1.4a
- Closed MSS at Roadrunner and Coyote
- HIMARS at H-1, will shoot as appropriate
- Next 24: 1.4a continues to Tikrit LOC site; 1.4a does Hwy 12 interdiction and stays on bridge by the dam, need permission to release them, need them for future raids
- D+14- 1.4a raid on Thar Thar, 1.4a continues movement to Tikrit 1.4a continues LOC interdiction on Hwy 12
