AQI's New Source for Suicide Bombers: Iraq

~~(S//REL)~~ **Assessment:** AQI continues to adjust due to the changing security environment. AQI's reliance on Iraqis will increase as Iraqi Security Forces and Coalition Forces efforts curtail the flow of foreign fighters along the Syrian border.

Pan-Arab Media Highlights



PM Maliki will continue to confront AQI and militias

PM Maliki says Iraq will continue to pursue AQI and outlaw militias to restore the rule of law. His statements come after successful operations in Basrah and Mosul, and as Maysan operations begin phase three – clearing government buildings and offices. National Dialogue Front threatens Iranian boycott

The Iraqi National Dialogue Front threatened to launch a public campaign to boycott Iranian goods in response to Iran's support of militias and the stationing of Quds Force operatives at the Iranian embassy in Baghdad. (*al-Sharqiya*)



Accord Front rules out approval of SOFA

Iraqi Accord Front spokesman Salim al-Juburi says the Sunni bloc ruled out approving any security agreement, if it infringes on Iraqi sovereignty. Issues of contention for the IAF include, military basing rights and security contractors' immunity from Iraqi law. (*Aswat al-Iraq*)
