- A more international character

- Be tailored to provincial and local requirements
- Military capacity relevant to security conditions and needs of Iraq
- Flexibility to expand and contract as security conditions warrant
- Facilitate force protection

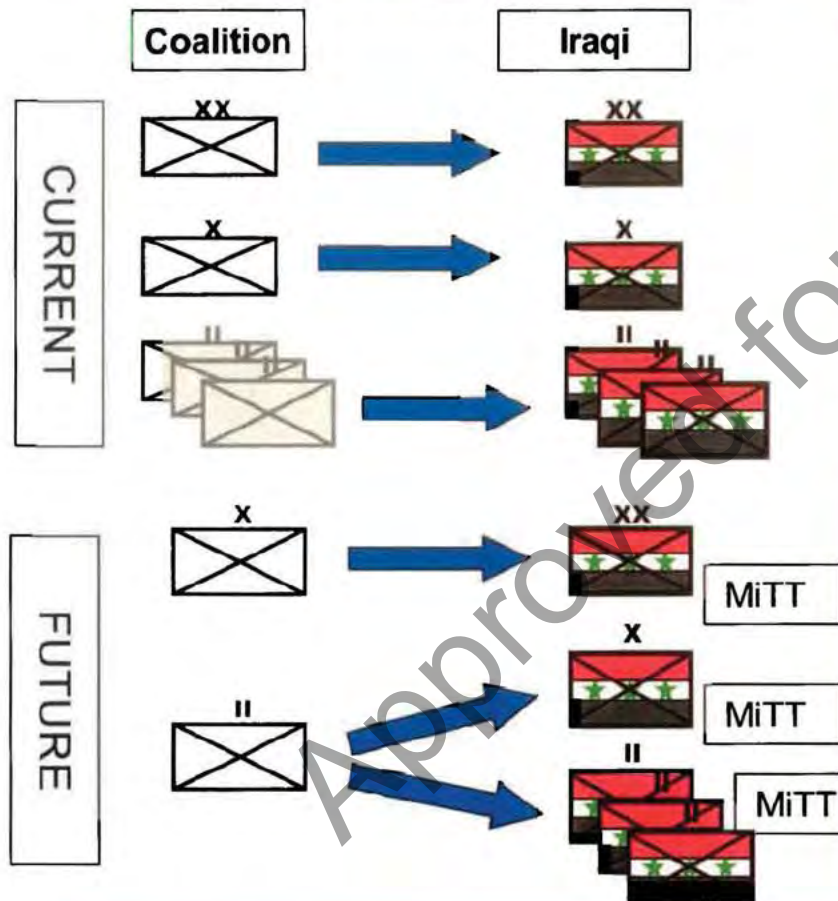
