Insurgent attacks are at typical level, with few effective during the reporting period. Sunni extremists between Yusifiyah and Mahmudiyah, as well as in the Radwaniyah area, are assessed to account for a significant portion of the overall attacks. JAM activity remains muted, with little reported activity after probable sectarianmotivated attacks east of Iskandariyah in Haswah.

In Ninewa, DF attacks remain the predominate attack method, increase CF presence has hindered IED operations directly increasing DF attacks. In Salah Ad Din, attacks continue to increase within Tikrit and Bayji, ISI movement into the area has caused attack levels to increase considerably over the past few weeks. In Diyala, AQIZ has been pushed out of Buhriz and Tahrir into western Baqubah, north of the DRV and to the south. Reporting indicates JAM gathering weapons for possible attacks in the near future. Nassir Farhan has possibly received a shipment of EFP's, which are reportedly being stored on Qasarin.

10 May 07 2/A/5-20 reported their vehicles struck an IED resulting in 1 x US WIA and destruction of the Stryker. When recovery arrived at the scene, a second vehicle was struck with an IED resulting in a second catastrophic loss.

On 8 May 07 Mayor Najim, BG Qais, BG Ibrahim, and The Tal'Afar City Council Director conducted a Town Hall Meeting at a local Tal'Afar Girls Secondary School in the Hassan Qoi neighborhood. The neighborhood has been plagued by AIF small arms attacks, mortar fire, and HBIED attacks over the past 3 months. Mayor Najim encouraged neighborhood residents to continue to provide intelligence to the ISF to combat terrorism in their neighborhood.

On 6 May 07 - The Diyala province PTT organized a 13 IP patrol in two vehicles and conducted a flash checkpoint near CP 412 on route Gold. The IP searched every vehicle that passed and checked ID on everyone both mounted and dismounted. The public seemed to have a positive reaction to the IP on the ground.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Fuel, Electricity, Security, Transportation remain at the forefront of public concern across the AOR.
- The Brinkley Group visited Mosul to assess SOEs and potential for investment by businesses.
- 96 billion dinars was transferred from the central bank of Iraq to al Anbar province on 8 May, and distributed to banks in Anah, Hadithah, Hit, Ramadi, and Fallujah.
- MNDs are in process of verifying location and status on all banks, hospitals, PDS warehouses, and gas stations. MNDs have assessed 121 banks of 522 identified; 42 assessed in MND-B, 40 of which were open.

TRANSITION

- Personnel and leadership shortages continue within the ISF. Lack of NCOs and Officers are compounded by DIV and BDE HQs having overages in these areas.
- The lack of a structured sustainment capability continues to undermine the ISF's ability to internally support operations. ISF units attempt to create decentralized capabilities to maintain readiness and address shortcomings. Particular problems exist in fuel distribution, maintenance capability, and replacing major end-items.

On 14 May, 5-20 IN conducted Regular Justice V, resulting in 8 x AIF KIA and one cache cleared consisting of 150 lbs of HME and various other munitions and documents.

COMMUNICATIONS

This week 3-4 CAV with the MNC-I PMO (b)(3) (b)(6) conducted a leader's engagement with the Tal Afar Mayor and ISF to discuss the investigations into the VBIED and the ensuing reprisal killings. The investigation being conducted by the PMO is focusing on evaluating the MOI investigation methods and their further development.

GOVERNANCE

15 MAY 07: The Qayyarah District has gone without its government food rations for two months and the people are also very concerned about the eminent deployment of 1/3/2 IA to Baghdad. The District IP Chief and City Council is confident that they will be able to pick-up the district's government rations on 16 MAY 07 with security provided by the IPs. Of more concern is the security of the area after 1/3/2 IA deploys.

ECONOMICS

Markets are improving in Zuhyrat, Dali Abbas, and Hamrin; this may be due to increased security posture of local ISF in these areas. Unemployment remains a large problem throughout the Qadah, but local governments are working to develop large-scale projects to reduce those who are out of work. The increased security posture throughout the Qadah has greatly improved the economic conditions for the people.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- MNDs are in process of verifying location and status on all banks, hospitals, PDS warehouses, and gas stations. MNDs have assessed 147 banks of 522 identified; 64 assessed in MND-B, all of which were open.

- ISF commitment to expanding role in maintaining security evident in actions in Nasariyah, Mosul, DUSTWUN soldier search operations, and response to damaged bridges in Baghdad.

- Personnel and leadership shortages continue within the ISF. Lack of NCOs and Officers are compounded by DIV and BDE HQs having overages in these areas.

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Insurgent groups in TF 1.4a AO are recuperating after increased activity this week. The absence of any reported attacks east of the Tigris River indicates that both JAM and Sunni extremists operating in the eastern region are concentrating on reconnaissance and resupply. A similar decrease in AO Denali indicates that Sunni insurgents there are doing much the same as they prepare for impending Coalition operations in Arab Jabour. Enemy activity in the Yusifiyah region and along the Euphrates River remains subdued due to aggressive Coalition DUSTWUN Operations.

DIYALA Activity remained elevated over the past week in Diyala as Baqubah remains AQIZ's main focus of attack in order to continue to discredit CF/ISF security, destabilize the local government and escalate sectarian violence throughout the region.

SALAH AD DIN Activity continues to increase within Samarra as ISI and AQI presence grows, majority of attacks targeted CF while conducting operations.

KIRKUK One of the attributes for the increased attack levels is the local mosques increasing their calls for martyrs. NINEWA Large scale attacks in the form of S/VBIEDs remain in Mosul; however, AQI are also targeting Kurdish

controlled cities still within AO Longknife.

RAIDER Activity in AO Raider will likely remain at steady levels as AIF have ceased to assess CF TTP and have started to conduct attacks.

WEEKLY SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

On 221210MAY2007 an IED detonated on MSR Tampa on a route clearance team from C/875th. The IED crater is 60m in width, 10m across, and 10 feet deep. Traffic opened on both lanes of MSR Tampa at 251600May07 largely in part due to the excellent work completed over the past two days by 105th Engineers.

On 24 May Lightning 6 conducted a leader's engagement with BG Biaz, the 3/2 IA Commander, and issued guidance to 5 82 FA. He spoke with 5-82 FA on denying AIF their usual sources of funding by ensuring the 46" pipeline is secured, the SIBs are supported and monitored, fuel smugglers are arrested or killed if caught and no one is extorting money from truckers or civilians.

- Suicide Attacks DOWN (9-7), below the 12 Week Average (12). Vest type attacks DOWN (3-1).

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Fuel, Electricity, Security, Transportation remain at the forefront of public concern across the AOR.
- 59 Community Stabilization Programs sponsored by USAID and International Relief and Development are ongoing between Fallujah, Ramadi, and Al Qaim, and are improving infrastructure and essential services.
- MNDs are in process of verifying location and status on all banks, hospitals, PDS warehouses, and gas stations. MNDs have assessed 147 banks of 522 identified; 64 assessed in MND-B, all of which were open.

TRANSITION

- East Rashid's IP recruiting with 1,115 Iraqi Police recruits successfully completing the screening process. MOI will next
 complete its official process, schedule initial entry academy training, and assign to stations.
- Personnel and leadership shortages continue within the ISF. Lack of NCOs and Officers are compounded by DIV and BDE HQs having overages in these areas.
- The lack of an effective sustainment capability continues to undermine the ISF's ability to internally support operations.

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Insurgent activity has remained below typical levels, with no significant activity reported east of the Tigris River. AO Denali remained quiet, indicating that Sunni insurgents in the area are possibly conducting preparations to counter Operation Marne Torch. Small arms fire in and south of Mussayib is attributed to extremist JAM, who are still assessed to be seeking retaliation against Coalition Forces for the detention of a local JAM leader. We continue to assess based on past patterns that insurgent attacks will increase significantly throughout TF 1.4a AO in the near future. Sunni insurgents around Yusifiyah are expecte to attempt several mortar and IED attacks targeting Coalition patrols.

DIYALA -The threat of S/VBIED in the Khalis market area will increase as JAM and AQI battle for influence of the city. We can expect to keep discovering bodies in and around Khalis as the enemy are kidnapping local nationals for ransom and killing them in the area.

SALAH AD DIN-CF operations in Tikrit proper, Ad Dawr, and the Owja and Wynot areas have resulted in the detainment of several battalion level HVIs. Reporting over the past week continues to indicate a possible large scale attack within Samarra, the Samarra Dam and other key infrastructure will most likely be the targets of choice. Reconstruction projects within Samarra will also be likely targets for AIF in the city.

KIRKUK- Propaganda near mosques continues to threaten any CF/ISF supporters.

NINEWA-Completion of large scale CF operations resulted in less CF presence which led to increased IED emplacement.

RAIDER- ISI within AO Raider, specifically in the Northern portion area, has likely finished assessing CF TTPs and is showing it by the increase of attacks on MSR Tampa and has shifted their TTPs to the routes traveled currently by CF.

WEEKLY SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

On the 27th of May T 1.4a escued 41 Iraqi civilians from an AQIZ prison camp south of Bagubah yesterday during Operation Al-Rasheed. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Fuel, Electricity, Security, Transportation remain at the forefront of public concern across the AOR.
- In Ramadi, the MNF is executing a stabilization plan that includes over \$26 million in its first two phases to restore basic infrastructure and government services.
- TF 1.4a visited AI Furat Chemical Plant in MND-C to negotiate a \$500,000 loan. Subsequent \$1.7 million deal will increase local employment by approximately 300 jobs.
- MNDs are in process of verifying location and status on banks, hospitals, PDS warehouses, and gas stations. 190 banks have been assessed of 522 identified; 107 assessed in MND-B, 8 of which were closed.

TRANSITION

- The Salah ad Din and Kirkuk Training Academies conducted 3 graduations on 27 May, totaling 985 Iraqi Policemen. The new Kirkuk IPs increase the city's assigned strength to 7,200 IPs.
- Personnel and leadership shortages continue within the ISF. Lack of NCOs and Officers are compounded by DIV and BDE HQs having overages in these areas.

Sunni insurgents around Yusifiyah are expected to attempt several mortar and IED attacks targeting Coalition patrols. AO Denali is prepared for a surge in Sunni insurgent attacks on static locations, such as Iraqi and Coalition patrol bases and checkpoints. DIYALA AQI/ISI continues to show strong resistance in Baqubah as recent reporting suggests that AQI is re-infiltrating within the Bagubah neighborhoods.

SALAH AD DIN CF operations within the Jabouri area will force AQI/ISI into the Divala, Tuz, and Samarra regions.

KIRKUK Bridges are being targeted to restrict ISF/CF and maintain AIF freedom of movement. ISI are slowly increasing their presence in AO Wolfhound.

NINEWA Coordinated attacks within the province will likely decrease as infighting amongst ISI causes disturbance in operations.

RAIDER It is likely that AQIZ leaders will flee into AO Raider as operations increase in Baqubah to seek protection.

At 1249 TF1 4 aD Co reports the final rollup of the cache which consists of 1 Catoosa rocket, 6x AT mines, 7x HME Fire Extinguisher Bombs, Scattered HME, several IED/HME making materials, to include wires, batteries, radios and cell phones, 1x VBIED rigged to blow with several bottles inside the trunk of the vehicle, possible HME.

COMMUNICATIONS- 4IA engineers have done an excellent job quickly emplacing culvert bypasses on both sides of the Sarihah Bridge, which was attacked earlier this week, 4IA and the Gol to continue to work toward a permanent repair solution which may take up to 6 months to complete.

GOVERNANCE-On 6 June 2007, Governor Hamad and Dep Governor Abdullah chaired the Provincial Sheiks Council meeting at the government building in Samarra. The primary purpose of the meeting was to discuss the way forward for the Sheiks against AQ. The Gov, Dep Gov, PDOP, BG Eissa (4th IA XO), and b 6 II emphasized the need for the Sheiks to work with the IA and IP in order to achieve security in Salah ad Din.

ECONOMICS-In Diayala Three BDE CERP projects were completed this week; constructions of the Divala Media Center (DMC) Sewage System, Purchase of Rice and Flour for Humanitarian Assistance Operations, and Mandali and Qazaniyah Water Project. Crop spraying continued throughout Diyala this week in Baqubah, Khalis, Muquadiyah, and the Diyala River Valley. The crop spraving project is expected to be complete within the week.

 discuss relationships and projects.
- Salah ad Din Gov and DGov chaired a Provincial Sheiks Council meeting and emphasized the need for the Sheiks to work with the ISF to achieve security; comments were broadcasted on Salah ad Din TV.

- MNF-West is implementing OP ALLJAH, a gated community project dividing the city into precincts. ISF recruiting and neighborhood watch programs are in progress.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Fuel, Electricity, Security, Transportation remain at the forefront of public concern across the AOR.
- The Ramadi branch of Rafidan Bank recently requested an additional allocation of 50 million dinars due to the rapidly
 growing economy; loans required for many farmers transitioning crops for growing season.
- MNDs are in process of verifying location and status on banks, hospitals, PDS warehouses, and gas stations. 190 banks have been assessed of 522 identified; 107 assessed in MND-B, 8 of which were closed.

TRANSITION

- 750 new IP recruits started a 4-week training course at the Baghdad Police HQS. 500 will be assigned to IP stations within Karkh Area Command and 250 to the Rusafa Area Command.
- Personnel and leadership shortages continue within the ISF. Lack of NCOs and Officers are compounded by DIV and BDE HQs having overages in these areas.
- The lack of an effective sustainment capability continues to undermine the ISF's ability to internally support operations.

SALAH AD DIN The terrain along RTE Dover is concealed from the majority of CF observation assets, and will continue to allow AIF to operate freely. AIF will continue to use gaps in patrol coverage to their advantage to initiate attacks on targets of opportunity.

<u>RAIDER</u> CF has been denied access into Shia areas where JAM elements are currently disgruntled with the attack against the Shia mosque and reporting continues to indicate that they are willing and prepared to retaliate against CF, who they believe, are responsible.

DIYALA There is an elevated risk of EFP and complex attacks targeting CF that use RTE Dover to travel between FOB Warhorse and KBS. Old Baqubah continues to be the focal point for AQIZ attacks, while elements in Western Baqubah prepare for operations against CF.

NINEWA AIF within Mosul likely planning large scale attacks, conserving VBIEDs for attack.

<u>KIRKUK</u> AIF will continue attempts to deny freedom of movement for CF/ISF logistics and security by targeting bridges that connect ASRs such as Cheyenne, Clemson and Cherry.

WEEKLY SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

①On 11 June 07 At 1524, 215th TOC reports an explosion in the Diyala Province; North Baqubah which destroyed the eastern end of the Diyala bridge by an SVBIED causing one of the two lanes to collapse.

On 13 June 07 there were 2 x Explosions at the Samarra Golden Mosque compound that targeted and destroyed the 2 x "Golden Minarets." There were no reports of casualties.

CURRENT ASSESSMENT

SECURITY & TRANSITION On Saturday, A/5-20 was engaged by AIF from a Mosque while clearing OBJ Walleye. AWTs engaged the mosque with 2 hellfires and a cordon was set in an attempt to prevent AIF escape. The mosque was cleared Saturday night by IA and CFs without further contact. No negative media coverage

COMMUNICATIONS Mayor Khalef noted the recent VBIED attack on BG Ali's house and ask coalition forces about assisting the individuals from the area.

On 141000JUN07-141500JUN07 the Local Mayors, ISF Commanders, 5-82 CDR and S3, CAT-A Team Leader conducted a Mayors' Meeting TRV Mayors meeting began with a review of the minutes from the meeting last month. Progress has been made on access to water, but Makhmur anticipates a shortage of fuel for water trucks.

GOVERNANCE 3-4 CAV CMO Team conducted a project assessment to emplace metal grates on six culverts along ASR Santa Fe from Tal Afar to Abu Mariyah. Some of the culverts along the route have already been filled with dirt. It has been determined by the CA element that a separate contract will be drawn up to remove the dirt and allow for the culvert repair to continue.

ECONOMICS This week in Mosul, The DCO, PRT Representatives, and CMO met with the Assistant Governor and the Acting DG of Agriculture. The problem for which this meeting was called was that a large quantity of fertilizer had been seized by Coalition Forces and the DG was requesting that we return it. The meeting ended up covering the larger issue of fertilizer being used in a majority of the HME in the area.

GOVERNANCE

- The Salah ad Din Province response to the Golden Mosque bombing was swift; the governor went to the site immediately
 with a media crew. The Governor, PDoP, and mayor all conducted media engagements to denounce the attack and
 encourage restraint. Multiple ISF elements are securing the area.
- MNF-W held several meetings with sheiks returning to Al Anbar after several years. The MNF expects that their strong stature will be a significant force multiplier in the counterinsurgency campaign.

SECURITY

- Total attacks were UP by 9% (1140-1246), <u>above the 12 Week Average</u> (1102). Effectiveness rate UNCHANGED (21%) and <u>below the 12 Week Average</u> (22%).
- Battle Casualties DOWN 17% (928-769), below the 12 Week Average (1071). Civilians DOWN 36% (483-308) below the 12 Week Average (655). ISF UP 27% (228-289), above the 12 Week Average (231). Coalition DOWN 21% (217-172), below the 12 Week Average (185).
- IED Events DOWN (685-663), above the 12 Week Average (655). 'F&C' Rate DOWN (45%-41%).
- VBIED events DOWN (29-18), 6 F&C. Casualties per attack DOWN at 9.1, below 12 Week Average (15.8).
- Suicide Attacks UNCHANGED (17), above the 12 Week Average (14). Vest type attacks UP (6-7).

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Fuel, Electricity, Security, Transportation remain at the forefront of public concern across the AOR.
- TF 1.4a visited National Metal and Bike in Mahmudiyah to assess its operations. This company is the second largest employer in the area, with 250 persons and the potential for 1000.
- MND-N led a Tal Afar Reconstruction Meeting to discuss the way ahead for utilizing \$37M in reconstruction funds. The Mayor stated that security is no longer a valid complaint for delays.
- MNDs are in process of verifying location and status on banks, hospitals, PDS warehouses, and gas stations. 190 banks have been assessed of 522 identified; 107 assessed in MND-B, 8 of which were closed.

TRANSITION

- Personnel and leadership shortages continue within the ISF. Lack of NCOs and Officers are compounded by DIV and BDE HQs having overages in these areas.
- The lack of an effective sustainment capability continues to undermine the ISF's ability to internally support operations.

MNC-I CURRENT OPS

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GOVERNANCE

- The provincial governor and several officials visited Hit on 17 JUN to assist in resolving issues with the city council legitimacy. A compromise was achieved, and 20 members were certified, which the MNF assesses as a sign of improved cooperation between the provincial and local levels of government.
- PM Maliki replaced the PDoP in Basrah; he will become part of the new Basrah Operational Command, which will replace the Emergency Security Committee.

SECURITY

- Isolation and clearing operations in Baqubah, Karmah, and Arab Jabour have been effective in both clearing AIF, and in having a positive impact on the population's support for ISF and CF.
- Total attacks were DOWN by 2% (1257-1237), above the 12 Week Average (1116). Effectiveness rate UP (21%-23%) and at the 12 Week Average (23%).
- Battle Casualties UP 57% (773-1212), <u>above the 12 Week Average</u> (1061). Civilians UP 104% (308-627) <u>above the 12 Week Average</u> (637). ISF UP 14% (290-330), <u>above the 12 Week Average</u> (231). Coalition UP 46% (175-255), <u>above the 12 Week Average</u> (194).
- IED Events UP (666-716), above the 12 Week Average (655). 'F&C' Rate UP (41%-44%).
- VBIED events DOWN (20-19), 3 F&C. Casualties per attack UP at 22.6, above 12 Week Average (15.9).
- Suicide Attacks DOWN (18-7), below the 12 Week Average (12). Vest type attacks DOWN (7-3).

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Fuel, Electricity, Security, Transportation remain at the forefront of public concern across the AOR.
- The ISF and CF escorted 22 fuel trucks from BOR to Al Anbar to distribute required fuel.
- Members of the RCT-6 EPRT met with (3) local national business leaders from Fallujah to explore the formation of a city chamber of commerce, a small business development center, and the development of a micro-finance center, as well as discuss micro-finance initiatives.

TRANSITION

- Personnel and leadership shortages continue within the ISF. Lack of NCOs and Officers are compounded by DIV and BDE HQs having overages in these areas.
- The lack of an effective sustainment capability continues to undermine the ISF's ability to internally support operations.
